

## Coronavirus (COVID-19) Update:

## Santa Clara County Lifts Mask Mandate

The Santa Clara County Public Health Department announced Tuesday it is lifting the indoor mask mandate for all individuals, regardless of vaccination status, effective Wednesday, March 2, 2022. It is the last of the Bay Area counties to end the indoor mask requirement.

Businesses are still permitted to voluntarily require masks for employees and customers.

California still requires masks in certain higher-risk settings, including public transit, healthcare facilities, shelters, jails, and long-term care facilities. More information about the state's remaining mask requirements is available <u>here</u>.
